We continue to donate quilts to Linus for teens graduating from the Foster Care Program, and welcome quilts of any size to be donated to area hospitals. Kits are available at meetings, and we continue to take donations of fabric, batting or thread.

We have gotten a request from UW Health for fidget blankets. These blankets are for "confused" patients to distract from medical apparatus, etc. You will find many ideas on-line, including Pinterest. Kits are available at meetings.

Specifications are as follows: 1) Blankets should be small enough to drape over a patient's lap.

2) All embellishments should be securely attached to the blanket. (This is must!)

3) Avoid small beads, baubles, etc, as they could become a choking hazard. Larger beads and buttons are acceptable as long as they are securely attached.

Any longarmers wanting to quilt a quilt top, please contact me. Batting and backing will be provided along with the quilt top.

Suggested quilt sizes for the Foster Care Program: 63" x 87" to 78" x 87".
