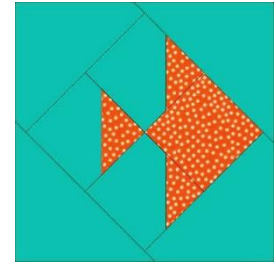

Although we are still experiencing the "winter" season in Madison, our theme this month is "spring," so we have a transitional subject for your sewing enjoyment—**Go Fish: From ice fishing to lake fishing!** It's a favorite hobby of many, and also a nod to tropical beaches, where we would all like to be at this time of year, perhaps snorkeling in nice warm water! Although the angles in this block may look difficult to make at first, they are not. This is a relatively easy block to make and you can whip up a whole "school" of them in no time. We just know you are going to be hooked (pun intended) once you sew the first one!

FINISHED BLOCK SIZE: 12.5" x 12.5"

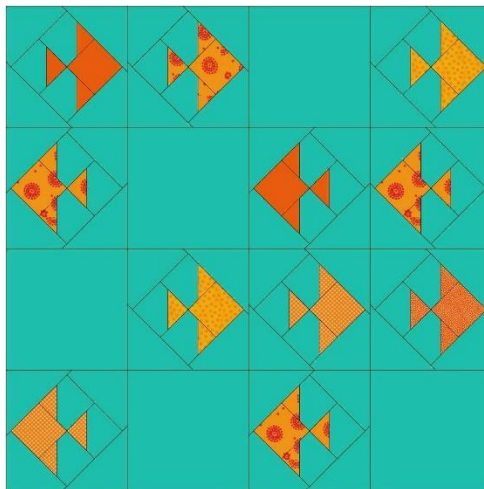
FISH BODY: **ORANGE, YELLOW ORANGE, RED ORANGE** (Geometric or small print)

FINS: **Same as the main fish square—or a companion fabric or solid**

BACKGROUND: **BLUE GREENS** (Aqua, Turquoise)(Solid, Texture, Ombre, or illusions of water)

DIRECTIONS: *See Separate Document*
