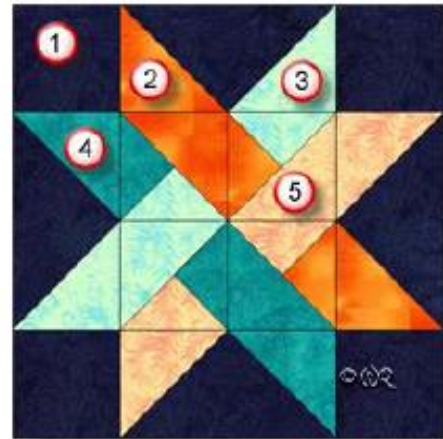


Patchwork Square

Free Quilt Block Pattern

Fabric Placement



Woven Star

8" finished quilt block

How-to Notes	
	Bisect square on one diagonal
	Bisect square on both diagonals
*All seam allowances are 1/4" unless noted otherwise	

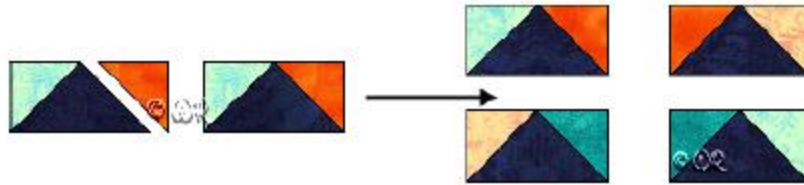
GWEN RECOMMENDS:

Cut 2 squares 3"

Cut 1 Square 3.5"

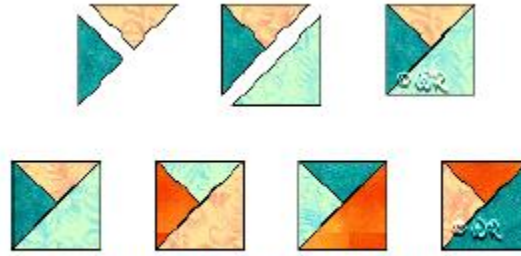
You will then trim individual sewn blocks to proper size before assembling final block design. See next page for details.

1		Background fabric 1 Cut 4 squares 2 1/2" Cut 1 square 5 1/4" and bisect on both diagonals
2		Fabrics 2, 3, 4 and 5 <i>From each of these fabrics:</i> Cut 2 squares 2 7/8" and bisect on one diagonal Cut 1 square 3 1/4" and bisect on both diagonals (* Note: For both sizes of triangles for each fabric, you will have extras to use in a second block)

Make 1 of each colour combination

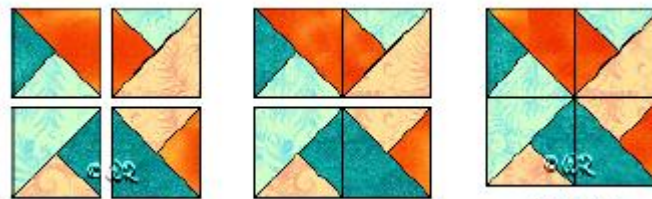
GWEN'S NOTE: Press seams of the Flying Geese toward the outside triangles. Trim blocks to 2.5" x 4.5." I highly recommend the "Wing Clipper" by Deb Tucker's Studio 180 Design.



Make 1 of each colour combination

GWEN'S NOTE: Press ALL seams open when making these blocks. Square each of the four blocks shown above to 2.5" x 2.5."

Then combine the four blocks into one larger center block as shown below, also pressing seams open. Finished center block should measure 4.5" x 4.5."



Make 1

GWEN'S NOTE: Add Flying Geese blocks around the center block, as shown below, and place the solid squares in the corners. Seams may be pressed open or nested, as desired. Unfinished block size should measure 8.5" x 8.5."
