

Cherrywood!!! -- See what it's all about!

Mad City Quilt Guild invites you to a hands-on opportunity to work with the luscious Cherrywood fabrics! **Karla Overland, from Cherrywood Fabrics, will present a workshop, "Infinity,"** from 9-12 on Tuesday, Sept 6, at Middleton Community Church (645 Schewe Rd, Middleton). Karla will lead us through the process to make this Infinity table runner. You will select your own 8-step colorway bundle (11 different options) from the Cherrywood website, and Karla will bring it to our class. No rulers. No measuring. No pinning. No batting. You'll cut free-form waves and layer them raw-edge on a foundation, to use the beautiful gradations of Cherrywood to their advantage, creating a simple, but effective modern quilt. The kit, purchased directly from the Cherrywood website (<https://cherrywoodfabrics.com/collections/karla-overland/products/infinity>) includes: pattern, 8-step fat quarter bundle (enough for 2 runners!), 2 yards Misty Fuse. For the workshop, you'll need to bring your sewing machine and basic tools (rotary cutter and mat, thread, etc.) Karla will provide some muslin for the foundation or bring your own 2 yards.

Orders must be placed by August 29, in order for processing to take place *before* the workshop.

The **Registration form** for the Cherrywood Infinity Runner is available on our website madcityquilters.org (under Calendar of Events -- Workshops & Retreats) for you to sign up and pay the \$35 workshop fee (Non members pay \$45). Use the registration form to get the discount code for free shipping when you order your kit.

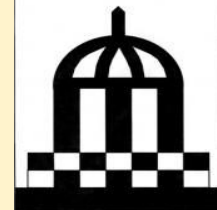

Aug 22, 2022 Chris Kirsch -- “Going Round and Round” -- Enjoy this trunk show of quilts while learning many different ways to add arcs and circles to your quilts! Piecing, applique and fusing will all be covered, plus a few surprises along the way.

Sept 26, 2022 Mary Alice Hart -- “Photo to Fabric” -- A digital slide and trunk show demonstrating a simple method of transforming your photos into fabric art. Your computer and printer can be used to create a master pattern and pattern templates, and like a jigsaw puzzle, the pieces come together to replicate the photo.
